Uninstall Instructions

To uninstall the current ASX Certificate Authority, from your PC, in Windows search, type **Internet Options**.

From Internet Options->Content->Certificates->Trusted Root Certificate Authorities.

NOTE: Please DO NOT Remove any certificates from your Personal tab

Find the highlighted certificate with expiration 08/01/2025.



Highlight the certificate and then click on **Remove**

1 *Installing ASX Certificate Authority* Prerequisites

The ASX Certificate Authority package is available on the <https://www.asxonline.com/public/documents/austraclear-technical-documents.html> under 'Austraclear Software'.


Click on the link **New ASX Certificate Authority**

Save the file **ca_public_key.zip** to the Desktop or to a suitable location on the C:\ Drive.

Unzip the file, and it will extract the file **ca_public_key.cer**.


Double Click on **ca_public_key.cer** and press OPEN to start the installation.




Click **Install Certificate**

Confirm Current User under Store Location, then Press Next.




Choose, Place all certificate in the following store -> Trusted Root Certification Authorities.



Then Press Next


You will then receive a Security Warning exactly as below:

Then press OK.




2 Checking the new ASX Certificate Authority
